THE PIONEERS IN AVIATION

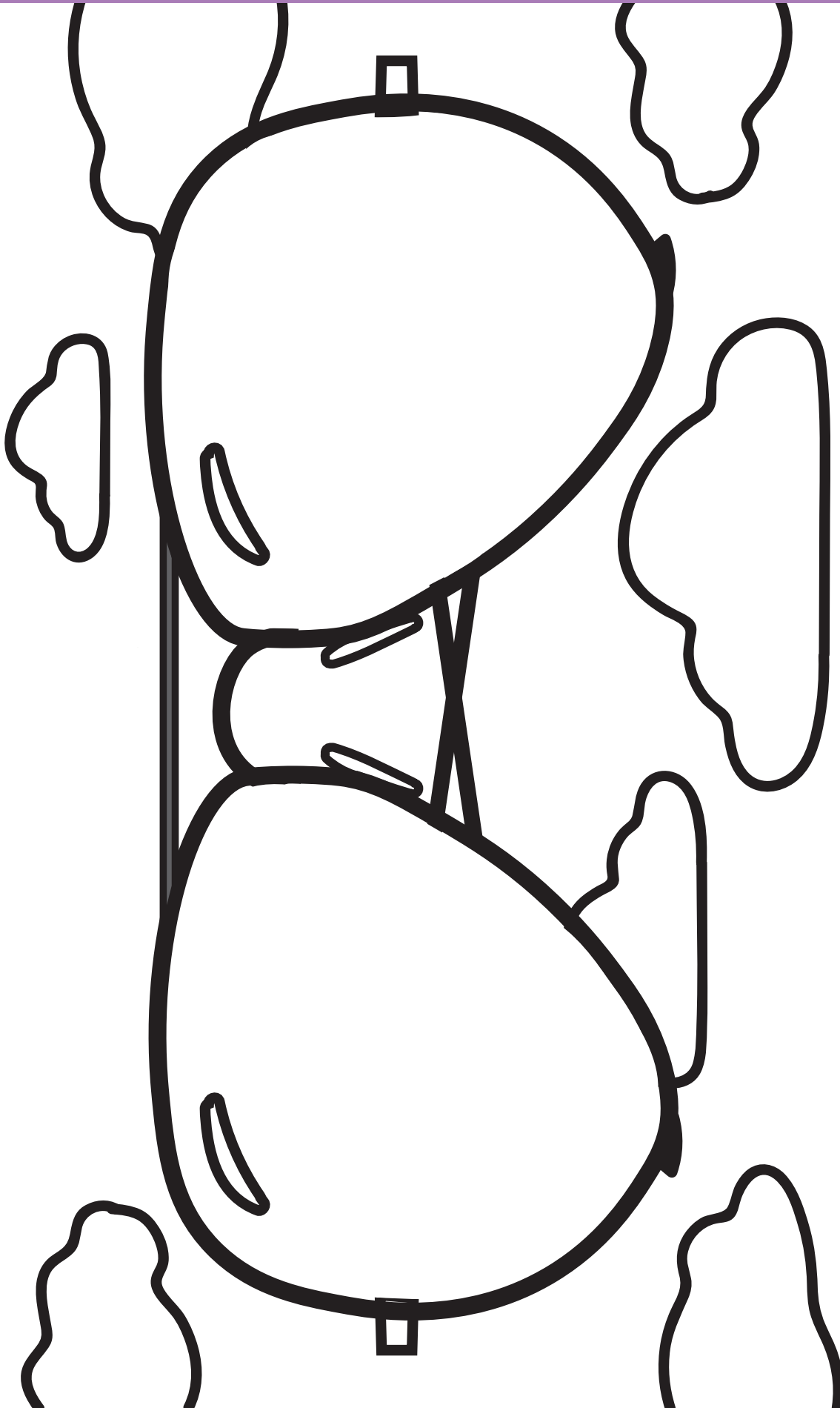
1. _____ was the first woman to fly across the Atlantic Ocean.

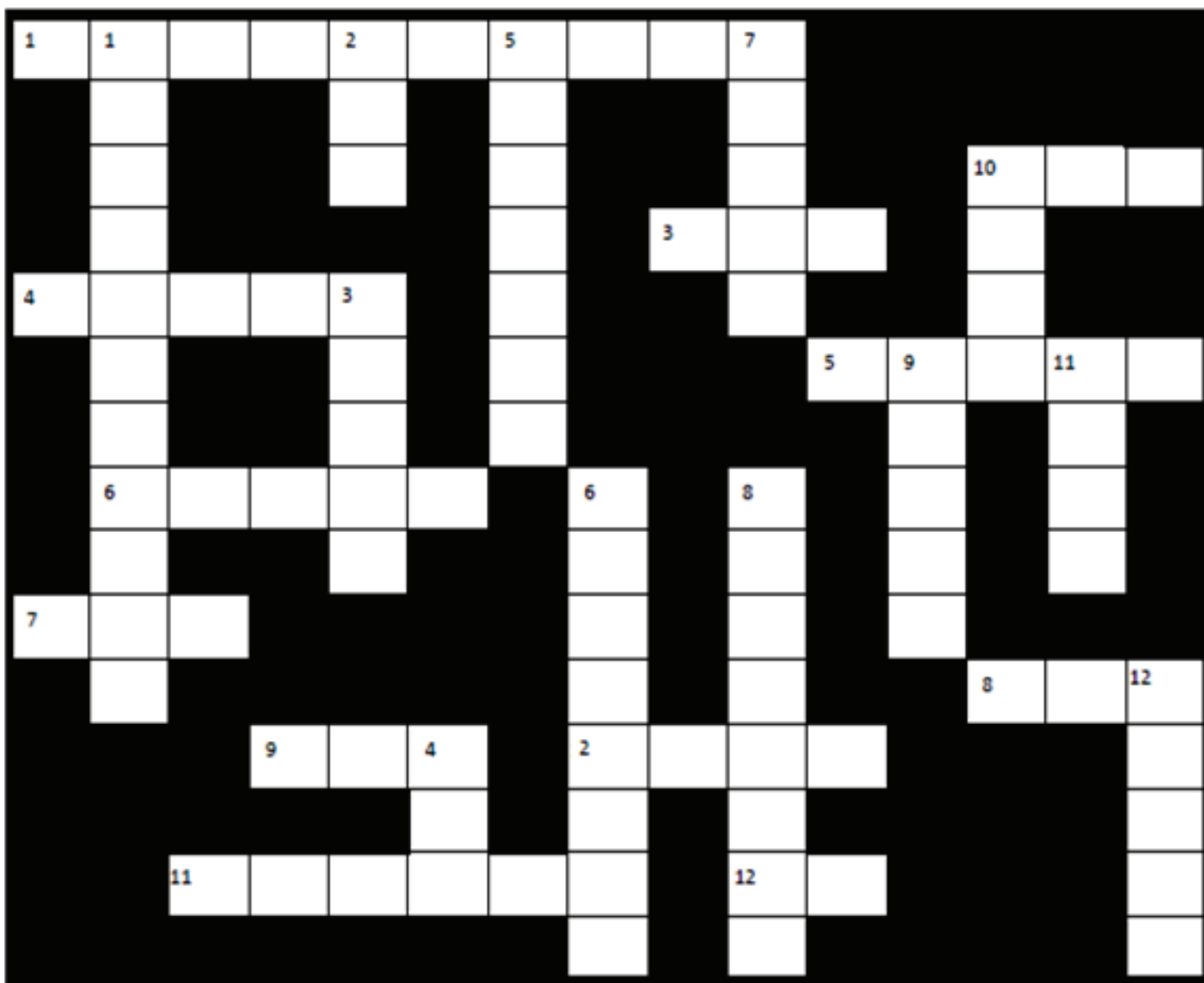

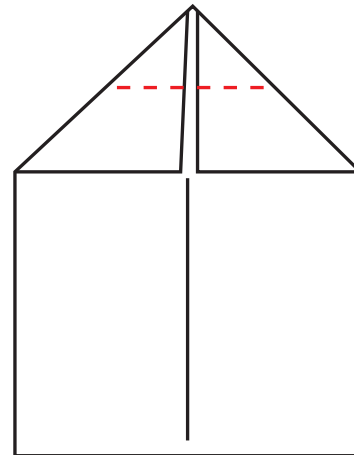

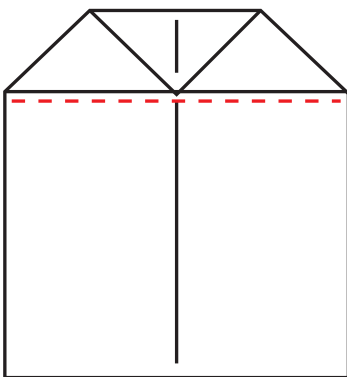

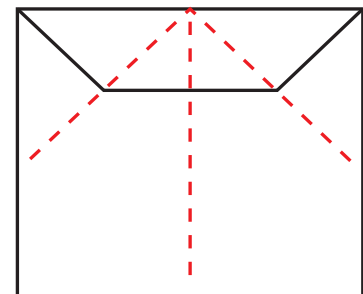
Fold an 8.5 x 11 inch sheet of paper in half lengthwise and open back up. Fold the top corners down to the center.



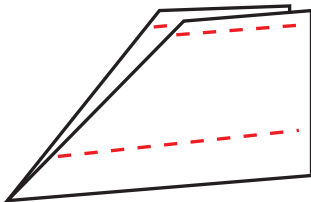
Now fold the point over to bottom of the previous folds.



Fold the top down.

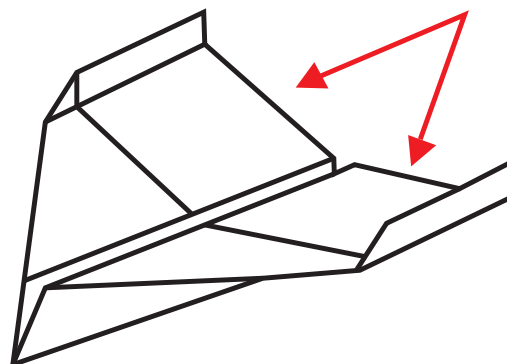


Fold the top corners down to the center. Fold the plane in half towards you.



Now fold the wings out at an angle as shown. Fold the wingtips up.

Bend the elevators up slightly for best flight.

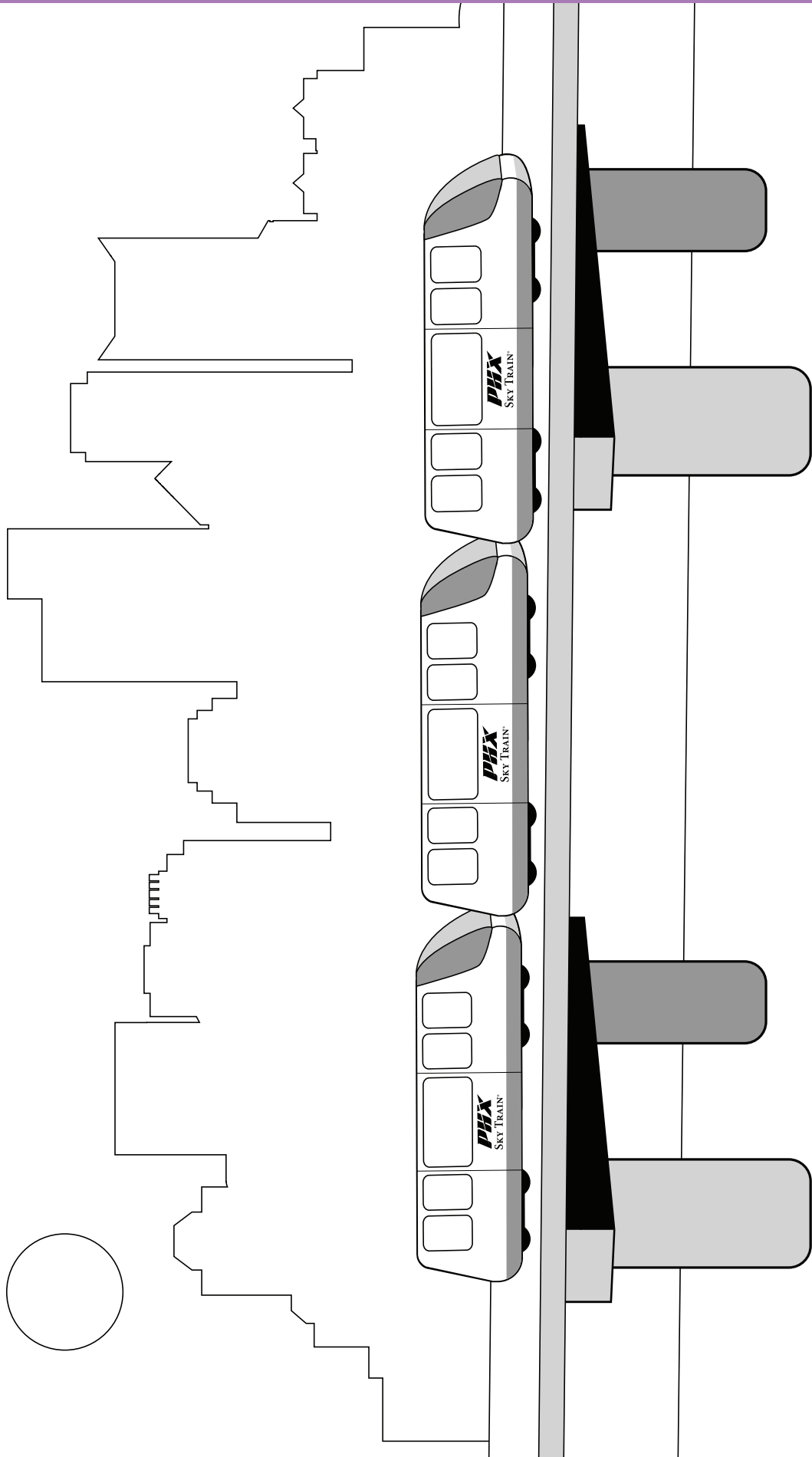

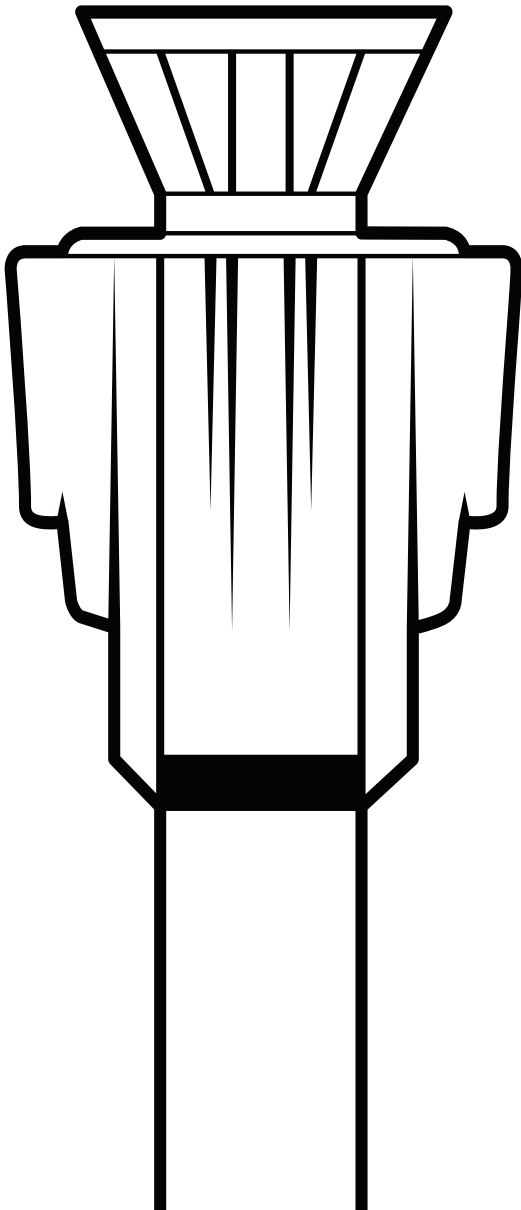


AVIATION ALPHABET

COMMUNICATION AND SAFETY ARE IMPORTANT IN AVIATION. THE INTERNATIONAL AVIATION ALPHABET WAS CREATED TO HELP PILOTS AND AIR TRAFFIC CONTROLLERS UNDERSTAND EACH OTHER.

Each letter is tied to a word to identify aircraft and airport taxiways. Using this phonetic alphabet is for optimal safety and avoids mistakes caused by familiar sounding letters. For example, the letters E and T and M and N can be mistaken for each other. Here is the Aviation Alphabet:

A - Alpha

B - Bravo

C - Charlie

D - Delta

E - Echo

F - Foxtrot

G - Golf

H - Hotel

I - India

J - Juliet

K - Kilo

L - Lima

M - Mike

N - November

O - Oscar

P - Papa

Q - Quebec

R - Romeo

S - Sierra

T - Tango

U - Uniform

V - Victor

W - Whiskey

X - X-ray

Y - Yankee

Z - Zulu
