GT Special Event VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS

Non-GT Providers

A Special Event Vehicle Permit is required for any Ground Transportation (GT) vehicle used in picking up passengers at Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport (PSHIA) for the duration of the event. The following outlines the processes and procedures required to permit GT vehicles more efficiently. All companies to provide driver/vehicle list in advance where possible.

Non – GT Providers “VEHICLE” Procedures

New vehicles added for the Superbowl

- Provide current registration or lease
- Provide a Certificate of Insurance ACORD with the following
 - Insured must have an A.M. Best rating of B+, VI
 - City of Phoenix listed as additionally insured
 - Minimum \$250,000 UM/UIM coverage listed on a separate line
 - Single-limit liability of \$250,000 for (1) to eight (8) passenger vehicles, including driver.
 - Single-limit liability of \$750,000 for (9) to eight (15) passenger vehicles, including driver.
 - Single-limit liability of \$5,000,000 for sixteen (16) passenger vehicle, including driver.
 - Issue color coded, laminated “Special Event” permit, to be displayed in the vehicle
 - Vehicles do not need a 19pt inspection if they are 10-year-old or newer
 - Fees will be charged according to the trip fees as of Jan 1, 2023, these fees will be self-reported to the finance department ([see self-report form](#))
