



# Badge Identification Requirements

TSA regulations require badge applicants to provide unexpired documents that establish both identity and employment authorization.\*

## BADGE APPLICANTS MUST PRESENT:

One (1) selection from LIST A

**OR**

A combination of one (1) selection from LIST B AND one (1) selection from LIST C

### LIST A

*Please bring one (1) of the following:*

- U.S. Passport or Card
- Permanent Resident Card
- Foreign Passport with I-551 stamp or I-94
- Employment Authorization Document (I-766)

### LIST B

*Please bring one (1) of the following:*

- State-issued Driver's License
- State-issued ID Card
- Federal, State, or Local government-issued ID Card
- Active Military ID Card

### LIST C

*Please bring one (1) of the following:*

- Social Security Card
- Certified Birth Certificate
- Certification of report of birth issued by the Department of State, Forms DS-1350, FS-545, or FS-240

**NOTE: A valid driver's License is required for all applicants seeking driving privileges**

## \*Born outside of the U.S. or the U.S. Territories?

Applicants born outside of the U.S. or the U.S. territories must provide one (1) of the following:

- Consular Report of Birth Abroad or Certification of Report of Birth; or
- U.S. Passport, Permanent Resident Card, or other List A document; or
- List B document, List C document, and your Alien Registration Number (A#)

# Badge Identification Requirements

One (1) selection from LIST A

OR

A combination of one (1) selection from LIST B AND one (1) selection from LIST C

### LIST A

Please bring one (1) of the following:

U.S. Passport or Card



Permanent Resident Card



Foreign Passport with I-551 stamp or I-94



Employment Authorization Document (I-766)



### LIST B

Please bring one (1) of the following:

State-issued Driver's License



State-issued ID Card



Federal, State, or Local government-issued ID



Green and/or Blue Military Card (Active)



### LIST C

Please bring one (1) of the following:

Social Security Card



Certified Birth Certificate



Certification of report of birth issued by the Department of State, Forms DS-1350, FS-545 or FS-240

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# Badge Identification Requirements

## ALL BADGE APPLICANTS MUST PRESENT:

One (1) selection  
from LIST A

OR

A combination of one (1) selection from  
LIST B AND one (1) selection from LIST C

### LIST A

*Please bring one (1)  
of the following:*

1. U.S. Passport or U.S. Passport card
2. Permanent Resident Card or Alien Registration Receipt Card (Form I-551)
3. Foreign Passport that contains a temporary I-551 stamp or temporary I-551 printed notation on a machine readable immigrant visa
4. Employment Authorization Document that contains a photograph (Form I-766)
5. For a non-immigrant alien authorized to work for a specific employer because of their status:
  - a. Foreign Passport; and
  - b. Form I-94 or Form I-94a that has the following:
    - 1) Same name as the passport; and
    - 2) An endorsement of the alien's non-immigrant status as long as that period of endorsement has not yet expired and the proposed employment is not in conflict with any restrictions or limitations identified on the form.
6. Passport for the Federated States of Micronesia (FSM) or the Republic of the Marshall Islands (RMI) with Form I-94 or Form I-94a indicating non-immigrant admission under the Compact of Free Association between the United States and the FSM or RMI.

### LIST B

*Please bring one (1)  
of the following:*

1. Driver's license or ID card issued by a state or outlying possession of the U.S., provided it contains a photograph or information such as name, date of birth, gender, height, eye color, and address
  2. ID card issued by federal, state or local government agencies or entities, provided it contains a photograph or information such as name, date of birth, gender, height, eye color, and address
  3. School ID card with a photograph
  4. Voter's registration card
  5. U.S. Military card or draft record
  6. Military dependent's ID card
  7. U.S. Coast Guard Merchant Mariner Card
  8. Native American tribal document
  9. Driver's license issued by a Canadian government authority
- For persons under age 18 who are unable to present a document above:
1. School record or report card
  2. Clinic, doctor, or hospital record
  3. Daycare or nursery school record

### LIST C

*Please bring one (1)  
of the following:*

1. Social Security Card, unless the card includes one of the following restrictions:
  - (1) NOT VALID FOR EMPLOYMENT
  - (2) VALID FOR WORK ONLY WITH INS AUTHORIZATION
  - (3) VALID FOR WORK ONLY WITH HDS AUTHORIZATION
2. Certification of report of birth issued by the Department of State (Forms DS-1350, FS-545, FS-240)
3. Original or certified copy of birth certificate issued by a state, county, municipal authority, or territory of the U.S. bearing an official seal
4. Native American tribal document
5. U.S. Citizen ID Card (Form I-197)
6. Identification card for use of Resident Citizen in the United States (Form I-179)
7. Employment Authorization Document issued by the Department of Homeland Security

Applicants born outside of the U.S. or the U.S. territories must provide one (1) of the following:

- Consular Report of Birth Abroad or Certification of Report of Birth; or
- U.S. Passport, Permanent Resident Card, or other List A document; or
- List B document, List C document, and your Alien Registration Number (A#)
